

# Fall Rabies Clinic



The Chowchilla Police Department along with assistance from Friends of the Madera Animal Shelter Chowchilla Chapter, will hold the **Annual Fall Rabies Clinic** on **Saturday, September 21** at the Chowchilla Police Department Station located at 122 Trinity Avenue. Times are from **9:00AM to 10:00AM** for seniors or persons with disabilities, and **10:00AM to 12:00PM** for the general public.


Distemper/Parvo, rabies, and worming shots will be available for dogs. FVRCD, rabies, and worming shots will be available for cats. Please note that **ALL CATS MUST BE IN CARRIERS**.

The Friends of Madera Animal Shelter (FMAS) will be offering low cost spay/neuter certificates during the clinic. The cost is \$20 for dogs, and \$15 for cats. Animal licensing from the Chowchilla Police Department will also be available at this clinic.

# NEW Trash Service Day for Two Neighborhoods



Starting September 1, all residents living within the highlighted area shown on the map above will be changing service days to the day listed on the map. # Annual City Curbside Cleanup Day

This is a **FREE ONCE A YEAR** service for Chowchilla solid waste customers in single family residences. Apartment or condominium residents should contact their landlord to arrange for special disposal issues. Gated community residents can contact their Homeowner's Association for disposal information. Residents with bin service on Robertson Boulevard and Defender Street will be contacted with special instructions. For specific questions, call Mid Valley Disposal at (559) 665-3099.

**The entire city**, except for Greenhills (your pick-up day is Saturday, September 28), will be picked up on **Saturday, September 21**. Please put your waste out near your curb before **6:00AM on Saturday, September 21**, but no sooner than the night before. Placing waste out earlier or later than **6:00AM** on the pick-up day will result in a special pick-up fee. All items not picked up per guidelines must be cleared from the curb within 72 hours. Every effort will be made to pick up your waste on the designated day. If it is not, please leave it out for pick-up the following day.

**FOR GREENHILLS RESIDENTS ONLY**, roll-off containers will be dropped off throughout the neighborhood on **Saturday, September 28**. You will be allowed to self-haul and dispose of any excess waste/material to these containers. If you need any assistance please contact your HOA.

Refer to the accompanying flyer for the "Do and Don't List" regarding the kind of waste that is acceptable. Be sure to place all waste at curbside, and remember, **DO NOT BLOCK** gutters, traffic lanes, or bicycle lanes.
