

Attend Important High-Speed Rail Meetings THE FUTURE OF CHOWCHILLA NEEDS YOU

The High-Speed Rail Authority has narrowed the bullet-train routes down to three that can affect the future of Chowchilla. HSR wants to hear from the community which routes are preferred and which ones are not. Should the rail project be built the High-Speed Rail Authority is asking Chowchilla what the Authority needs to do to offset the impact of the rail system on the community.

The City of Chowchilla City Council is holding community meetings seeking public comments on the preferred rail route options and to gather publicly generated ideas for future community improvement projects. These meetings will then produce a report that the City of Chowchilla will submit to the High-Speed Rail Authority in the coming weeks.

"Fall Clean-Up Drop-Off Day" September 26


Mid Valley Disposal and the City of Chowchilla join together on **Saturday, September 26** for the "**FALL CLEAN-UP DROP-OFF DAY**" when Chowchilla residents can drop-off their collected **BULK TRASH** at an in-town site for **FREE** from **7AM to 3PM**. The event is **ONLY** for residents living within the Chowchilla city limits and you **MUST** provide proof of residency in the form of a driver's license or City utility bill with a printed address.

The drop-off location is the "City Site" at 24252 Road 15-1/2, Head south on 15th Street from Robertson Boulevard that will curve into Road 15-1/2. There will be signs directing you to the drop-off location.

THIS IS A "DROP-OFF ONLY" EVENT—DO NOT PUT ITEMS AT THE STREET CURB OF YOUR HOME AS THEY WON'T BE PICKED UP.



Pet Rabies Clinic Coming September 12

The Friends of Madera Animal Shelter with assistance from the Chowchilla Police Department will hold the **Annual Fall Rabies Clinic** on **Saturday, September 12** at the Chowchilla Police Department Station located at 122 Trinity Avenue. Times are from **9:00AM to 10:00AM** for seniors or persons with disabilities, and **10:00AM to 12:00NOON** for the general public.

Parvo/Distemper (\$12), rabies (\$6), and worming (\$5) shots will be available for dogs. FVRCD (\$12), rabies (\$6), and worming (\$5) shots will be available for cats as well.

NOTE THAT ALL CATS MUST BE IN CARRIERS.

The Chowchilla Police Department will also offer pet licensing during the clinic.

The Friends of Madera Animal Shelter (FMAS) will also offer **FREE** spay/neuter certificates during the clinic thanks to a grant from the Nancy & Arnold Red Foundation.
