FIREWORKS BOOTH SALES LOTTERY DRAW APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCESS

CMC Title 8

Organizations must meet the following eligibility qualifications to submit a **FIREWORKS BOOTH SALES LOTTERY DRAW APPLICATION**:

- An application must be fully completed at time of submission; incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- An application must be submitted to the City of Chowchilla Community and Economic Development Department during business hours between June 1 and June 30.
- Applicants must be nonprofit organizations, associations or corporations organized primarily for veteran, patriotic, welfare, civic betterment or charitable purposes.
- An applicant organization must have its principal and predominant meeting place in the corporate limits of the City of Chowchilla, and maintain a membership of at least twenty (20) members.
- An applicant organization must be organized and established within the City's corporate limits for a minimum of one year preceding the submission of an application.
- No organization may receive or possess more than one fireworks booth sales permit in a calendar year.
- If an applicant organization has multiple auxiliary or direct affiliate organizations the primary organization and one auxiliary or affiliate organization can submit an application for the fireworks booth sales lottery draw; if one of these organizations is selected the other will no longer be considered eligible to receive a permit in the same time period.

The selection process for the fireworks booth sales lottery draw is as follows:

- The City of Chowchilla will give first priority to Veterans organizations that meet the application requirements.
- The City of Chowchilla will give second priority to nonprofit corporations that meet the application requirements.
- Following the assignment of permits to eligible Veterans organizations, the remaining available permits will be assigned through a random drawing of all remaining eligible applicants conducted during a regular meeting of the Chowchilla City Council in the month of July.
- All applicants will be notified of their permit eligibility status as soon as possible following the fireworks booth sales lottery draw by the Chowchilla City Council.
- Each organization will hold a permit for two consecutive years.
