



## ALCOHOL PERMITS (CMC 9.08)

The Chief of Police may issue a permit allowing consumption/possession of alcoholic beverages in places that would otherwise be prohibited. You must file an application 30 days prior to the date the public consumption is requested. The permit must specify the geographical boundaries in which consumption of beverages will be allowed, and any consumption of outside of this boundary will be considered a violation. You may apply for an alcohol permit at the Police Department located 122 Trinity Avenue.




All above permits are time sensitive. In order to assist you and your request it is suggested to contact the Community Development or the proper Department as soon as possible for processing.

## BANNER & SPECIAL EVENTS

### PERMITS

You will need an encroachment permit to hang a banner, decorations, have a parade, or special event that will take



place on Robertson Blvd. (State Route 233). An Application can be picked up at in the Community Development Department, Civic Center.



### FIREWORKS PERMITS (CMC 8.24)

To sell fireworks in the City of Chowchilla you need a fireworks permits. There are only four (4) permits issued in the City of Chowchilla for the purpose of selling fireworks. The permits are issued for a two (2) year consecutive period by a lottery draw at a City Council meeting in the month of July. Any Agent/Organization that would like to participate in the lottery draw will need to put their application in at the Community Development Department during the month of June and it will be forwarded to the City Clerk's office for processing in the lottery draw. When you have been notified that your

organization has been chosen in the lottery draw you will submit an application and your information at Community Development Department, Civic Center.

### RV PERMITS (CMC 10.28)

RV's may be parked upon any street for a period of seventy-two hours or less, for the purpose of loading, unloading or preparing the vehicle for use, or to carry out emergency repair for a period of twenty-four hours or less; provided, such person shall notify either in person or by telephone the police department of the City before parking the recreational vehicle on the street.



RV permits may be issued to accommodate visitors who are not residents of the city and guests of the owner. They may park the recreational vehicle in the street adjacent to the host residence for not more than fourteen days; provided, that parking room is available there, and that parking the RV does not constitute a safety hazard. Contact the Community Development Department to notify them of the RV and to obtain a permit that can be displayed in the window of the RV.

The City will issue at no charge, a written permit at Community Development Department, Civic Center to the owner which is valid for a period of up to two weeks.

### YARD SALE PERMITS (CMC 5.36)



The City of Chowchilla requires residents to get a yard sale permit prior to their yard sale. There is no charge for the first three (3) yard sale permits per calendar year. A charge of \$15.00 each will be charged for the fourth, fifth, and sixth permit not to exceed six (6) yard sale permits per calendar year. Only six (6) sales are allowed per calendar year for churches, fraternal organizations, or other non-profit entities at no charge. Yard sale permits may be obtained at Civic Center.



### TRANSPORTATION PERMITS (CMC 10.52)

To move or operate any vehicle on a city street with a load or loads in excess of those permitted by the Vehicle Code will need a permit.
