Chowchilla's Easter EGG Scramble is Saturday, April 8

On Saturday, April 8 kids will be hopping all around Edward Ray Park as the City of Chowchilla presents the annual Chowchilla's Easter EGG Scramble for children 12 years old and younger.

NEW THIS YEAR! Start your morning off before the scramble events with real scrambled eggs and pancakes! The Chowchilla American Legion and VFW will host their monthly pancake breakfast at the park from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Included in the meal are pancakes, scrambled eggs, sausage, juice and coffee. The cost is \$6.00 for ages 10 years and older and \$4.00 for kids younger than 10 years.

Chowchilla's Easter EGG Scramble activities begin at 9:30 a.m. for the very youngest children with the opening of the FREE Bunny Trail for ages 3 and younger, and any age person with special needs.

There are schedule and location changes this year for the various age groups to scramble for Easter eggs and candies. Scrambles for kids in the 4-5 and 6-7 years old age groups will be at 10:15 a.m. Then at 10:45 a.m. kids in the 8-9 and 10-12 years old age groups will run their scrambles. All Easter EGG Scrambles will be held in the park softball fields.

Once again this year the City will have FREE bounce houses for the kids to play on. The Chowchilla 4-H will sell temporary tattoos as a fundraiser for their activities. The Greenhills Lions Club will sell guesses for the Jelly Bean Count Guessing Contest where you can try to win the huge jar of jelly beans with proceeds coming back into the Chowchilla community. The Chowchilla District Chamber of Commerce will hold a FREE drawing to win a gift basket.

Edward Ray Park is at 625 North 15th Street, north of Robertson Boulevard and south of Ventura Avenue.
